## The Miracle.....

- 1. Teaches us if God will provide for a crowd in the wilderness He will provide for His child of grace.
- 2. Teaches us God's provision is abundant.
- 3. Teaches us when God meets our needs we need to cherish His provision.
- 4. Teaches us to trust God for what we need not worrying about how we will get it.
- 5. Teaches us that we too have a part in the work that Jesus is currently doing through serving with our gifts.
- 6. Teaches us to find life's satisfying provision in Him.

I. <u>The Disciples **ASSUME** a Challenge:</u> Believers may assume there is a challenge when Jesus has designed an opportunity to trust Him. 12 Mt. 14:15-21; Mk. 6:35-44; John 6:4-13 II. <u>The Disciples **AMNESIA** is a Problem</u>: Believers suffer from spiritual amnesia as they look inward to solve their problems forgetting the faithfulness of Christ . 13-14a
